We are well and truly into the term now with many children starting to feel tired. You may notice this reflected in their behaviours as they start to struggle with coming to kindy and separation when perhaps before they didn't. It is important to acknowledge your child's feelings and in doing so you are letting them know that how they feel is okay and normal and that with your support they will get through it. Children develop their identities from the relationships and the people around them. They learn how to respond and who they are as individuals through these interactions and feedback from those close connections. It is important therefore that we consider what we say and how we react when faced with difficult behaviours in general.

Powerful learners feedback Thank you to those families who have taken the time to fill out the form in relation to their own child. Staff will use this information to support further learning goals. It will be interesting to see if there is a shift in your child by the end of the year.

Immunisations. Just a reminder that we need to see your child's immunisation schedule for our records before the end of this term. We still have a considerable number of families who have not presented their immunisation records to staff.

Spare clothes. Can you please ensure your child has suitable spare clothes in their bags especially if they are likely to be engaged in sand and water play as we are running out of shorts and jocks.
