Staff have been exploring the notion of powerful learners using a growth mindset and learning dispositions. Through this we are supporting our children to engage in authentic problem solving and critical reflections of their own learning. Children are learning about growing their brains by making connections in their learning. They are having to experience challenges and take risks, feel what it's like not to succeed and try again, challenge their ideas to change perspectives and persist and then know what it genuinely feels like to succeed. By doing this with our children we are supporting them to be truly engaged in their own learning and have strong foundations for future learning opportunities.
